



# Hackathon rules



- Each team will have four members.
- The link to the online test will be shared before the start of each round.
- Teams will compete by answering multiple choice questions in 120 minutes.
- Each team will be required to attempt 60 questions in both the rounds in the designated time period.
- Relax - there is no negative marking for wrong answers in any of the rounds.
- It is recommended that you close all other applications on your machine before continuing with the round.
- Teams will be disqualified if they enable screen sharing.
- Teams are expected to have a browser setup on their machine, preferably Chrome, Firefox, or Safari.
- If you are not able to continue your test due to a network issue or any other challenge, please contact your coordinator for next steps.
- Round 1 is not an elimination round.
- Results will be announced at the end of the second day after combining the scores from rounds 1 and 2.
- The evaluation of your responses is completely automated through the online platform.
