

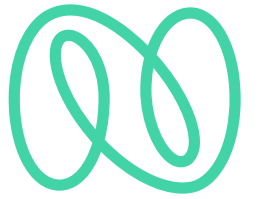

What is that one quality that has helped you along your career path?

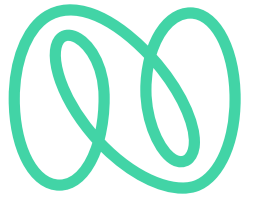

Who is your personal role model?

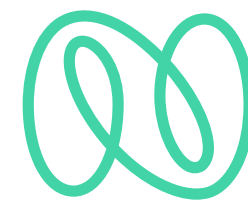
