The Neumanns at Lake Feuersee




I like cool surprises!

But do you know what's even cooler? It's not just a bike - it's


an e-bike! And on top, there's something that looks like cycling glasses!??

Finally, the day arrived! Today, it was time for the promised ride. Mom packed sandwiches, Dad took his handyman kit, and I prepped Teddy for the ride.


Once everything was set, we put on our cycling glasses. We could in-






Riding at the speed of light? No!


Lazy Dad


17,0 km/h 542 kcal 14,4 km
