

Climb up the upper floors of the Hawa Mahal and peek down at the old city through one of its many windows.



The best thing to do in and around Windstein is hiking!
And explore the spots around – the magical forest, ruins, military areas (bunkers), lakes, and historical sites.

My favorite spots in Windstein are the ruins, especially that of the Château du Nouveau Windstein. You can sit at one of the several very well-preserved window sills here, even if it's raining, and enjoy the exceptional view of the "la Plaine du Rhin" (the Rhine plain).

On the other side of the mountain encircling the village, there are the ruins of the Château du Vieux Windstein. Spread over a much larger area, this ruin isn't that well maintained but offers a wide range of climbing possibilities.

Hôtel-Restaurant du Windstein offers fresh and seasonal meals, and the typical eau de vie. Also, I suggest trying out the fresh cheese products from the nearby goat farm.
