

The callenge

Klosterfrau, a company with a long and rich tradition, was planning as part of a general company reorganization to modernize its legacy structures and processes, to bring them more in line with its international growth strategy. In the first stage, three of the company's locations in Germany, with around 600 employees and three different ERP systems, would be affected.

As part of a consolidation project, SAP S/4HANA would be implemented at these three locations as a shared SAP ERP solution. One major goal was to merge and harmonize master data as well as processes from these three locations. Two of these locations were previously using a SAP ERP system and one was using a non-SAP solution. A more process-based focus was needed in the future and less of a focus on departments and other units, which is why there was a need for efficient, standardized and scalable processes.

The solution

To identify the optimal ERP solution given the maximum possible number of standard processes, Nagarro ES conducted a preliminary study. Based on the results, the company selected SAP S/4HANA and the Fit4Life science template from Nagarro ES. The template is based on preconfigured and standardized end-to-end processes and best practices in the pharmaceutical industry, and it is specially customized and scalable for Klosterfrau. One example that demonstrates this is that of the approx. 2000 internally developed Z-programs, less than a hundred were brought over to the new system – as a result, the IT architecture is now significantly closer to standard and is far less complex. All project phases were completed using established methods to avoid unnecessary friction wherever possible and to complete the implementation without complications.

As an overall project method, PRINCE2, a process-based approach, was used. The concept design phase followed the agile scrum methodology and SAP R/3 was migrated to SAP S/4HANA with the Greenfield approach.
